

**FAMILY/SUPPORT PERSON INFORMATION FOR WITHDRAWAL MANAGEMENT**

**What to expect?**

Your loved one will be staying an average of 3-5 days depending on the substance they have been using. The nurse does an evaluation each day.

Once they are medically cleared/ready to leave, we offer bus tickets for transportation or they can schedule a ride.

All individuals can choose to leave at any time. No one can be held against their will.

Due to the short stay, this inpatient unit does not offer visitation days/times.

**Can I call to check up on their well-being?**

We always accept messages from loved ones. Your family member/friend will be responsible for returning the call if they choose to do so.

**What if they have to go to the hospital?**

We have wonderful nursing staff available 24/7 to determine the needs of a person while in our care. If they need to be sent out, we will notify their emergency contacts (with their permission).

The emergency contact person cannot pick them up to transport to or from the hospital or anywhere else while they are admitted to withdrawal management services.
